Upon successful completion of this module, students will demonstrate proficiency in anatomy, physiology, and pathology while engaging in a code of conduct beneficial to their clients.

- Completion of module 2 should take approximately 100 hours.
- The course is delivered through home study and includes detailed pictures, and videos to support the material.
- Students need to complete a quiz with each lesson, these do not need to be handed in, and are for students own knowledge testing.
- At the end of the module, there is a short answer assignment that needs to be completed and emailed in.
- It is recommended for students to join the private facebook group that was emailed at registration to receive peer support for studying and making connections.

Upon completion of the course, the student will demonstrate proficiency in:

- Classifying the main systems of the body
- Identify the major structures of each system
- Identify and differentiate the major pathologies for each body system

Evaluation and Grading

All quizzes are for students own study, they do not need to be handed in for grading. One assignment at the end of the course to be handed in, and the board certified final exam.

Once you pass your assignment with 75% and demonstrated knowledge of the various body systems, you will be ready to write the exam.

Final Exam

- The Final exam is a National board exam. You must sign up for it from our website. If you have already signed up for the aromatherapy exam, you do not need to sign up again.
- You must pass the exam with a 75% to pass the course and be eligible to become a CFA and/or NAHA member.
- The exam is online, so you do not need to find a proctor.
- The anatomy portion of the exam must be written within 2 weeks of the Aromatherapy portion.
